

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in guestion cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition logged twice daily while on the competition grounds.
