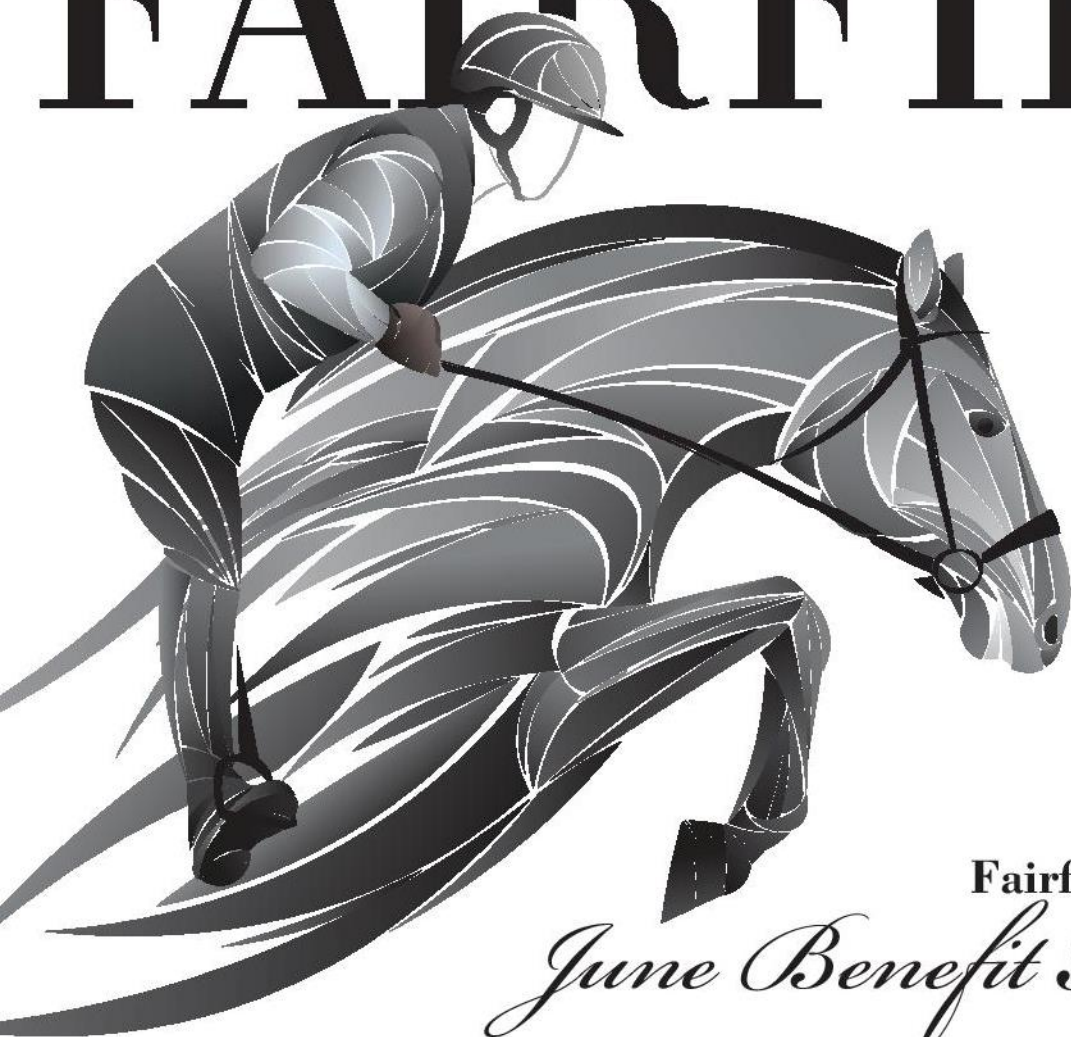

THE EMERSON BURR HORSEMANSHIP GRANT

The Emerson Burr Horsemanship Grant will be awarded to the highest scoring participant of each of these four age groups: 8 and under; 9-11; 12-14; and 15-17. Each winner at the zone level receives a \$100 grant to use towards educational related expenses.

Riders competing in Regular Hunter Pony, Green Hunter Pony, Pony Medal, Pony Jumpers or Children's Hunter Pony are eligible to participate in this program. Each participant will take a short, multiple choice test on horsemanship, which contains no more than 20 questions and respond to a short essay question. A winner will be selected from each age group based on the results. Grant information forms received by winners must be returned to USEF by November 15, 2017.

The Emerson Burr Grant will also be offered on a National Level during the 2017 US Pony Finals presented by Collecting Gaits Farm. So start sharpening your horsemanship knowledge! Check with the horse show office to see how you can participate!

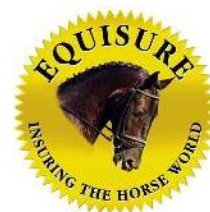

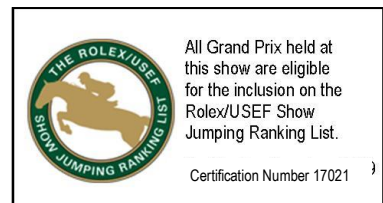
