Open to riders who have not reached their 7th birthday and have not competed in any classes in a USEF OR CHJA Recognized show other than leadline. Entries may be asked to trot. Riders to be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. An adult is required to lead each entry.

### **PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION**

Open to junior riders who are eligible for Limit Equitation over fences as of December 1 of the current show year and have never shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. Riders may show horses or ponies. Fence height 2'0". At the same show, riders may not cross enter into Children's Equitation, Children's Pony Hunter, Pony Hunters, any Medal classes that exceed 2' or any class where fences exceed 2'6". No combinations permitted. CHJA Points

### **CHILDREN'S EQUITATION DIVISION**

Fences for horse and large ponies 2'6" in height. Fences for small/medium ponies 2'0" in height. Combinations are prohibited. CHJA Points.

Riders in this division may not compete in any class at the same show where obstacles exceed 2'6". CHJA Points.

## Rules and Regulations

1. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA/NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA/NEHC Rules. To show in CHJA/NEHC Medal Classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA/NEHC annual year end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA/NEHC and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA/NEHC. A copy of the Rule Books, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office or online.
2. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management; but Fairfield County Hunt Club will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendant hold Fairfield County Hunt Club and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show.
3. If any questions or disputes arise, same will be referred to the steward & show committee, whose decision shall be final.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for having accurate and current memberships for all organizations which require the same. Any fines levied against the horse show for incorrect exhibitor memberships shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
5. \$50 Fee for any returned checks, or unpaid entries that must be billed.
6. Entries close 24 hours prior to show. Post entries \$25

MERRITT PARKWAY (R L 15) - EXIT 42 (W eston Rd)

Coming from New York - Turn Left on Rt. 57 New Haven - Turn Right on Rt. 57

Don't continue on Rt 57 - Take a left at fork in road (Weston Road) Go straight until you can't go any further, then turn left (Cross Highway) . Go 1 mile to first stop sign (North Ave) then turn right. Go a little more than a mile until you can't go any further and turn left (Long Lots Road). The Hunt Club is on the right about 1 mile - Look for the Polo Field.

1-95 FROM NEW HAVEN (Southbound)

Get off at Exit 19. At the bottom of the ramp you will come to a stop sign (you will see The Box Car Cafe on the right) Go straight to the traffic light, take a right onto the Post Road (Route 1). At the third traffic light take a right onto Bulkley Avenue (An AT&T Wireless Building will be on your right at the light). Bulkley Avenue is a long winding road at the end of it is a stop sign, take a left (you will see a large polo field on your left) onto Long Lots Road. Take your first left into our driveway.

1-95 FROM NEW YORK (Northbound)

Exit 18 - Sherwood Island. At the end of the ramp turn left. Go approximately 1 mile to Post Road (Rt. 1). You will see the Bertucci Restaurant on left. Turn left - then take a quick right. You will be on Long Lots Road right in back of the restaurant. Go straight for about 1½ miles. The Hunt Club is on the right. If you start passing our Polo Field you have gone too far.

POST ROAD FROM NORWALK: Take a left just before the Bertucci Restaurant, then a right in back of the Restaurant (Long Lots Rd). Go straight for about 1½ miles. The Hunt Club is on the right.

POST ROAD FROM FAIRFIELD: Take a right on to Bulkley Avenue. Go all the way to the stop sign (approx. 1½ miles). Turn left onto Long Lots Rd and take the first left into our driveway.
