### **SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION**

Open to riders 12 years and under who have never competed over fences exceeding 18" in an USEF or CHJA Recognized show. Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or recognized class in a show with fences exceeding 18" except for pleasure and pet-type pony classes. Shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Diagonals and leads considered. Riders will be asked to jump a course of at least four, but not more than eight, obstacles. All jumps must be cross-rails, not to exceed 18" in height. May trot or canter over obstacles. CHJA Points.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF, CHJA, NEHC & FWPFA Rule Books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

2. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

3. Hunter fences to include brush, gate, wall, in and out, aiken, natural rails. Jumper fences to include brush, coop, wall, planks, panels liverpools, natural obstacles and rails.

4. All classes to be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

5. Fairfield County Hunt Club and the Horse Show Committee shall not be liable whatsoever for any injury or damage to any person or property of any spectator, visitor, exhibitor, attendant or any other persons, or animals by reason of any event occurring during the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the same as well as their agents and/or employees harmless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.

6. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries so warrant. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry (in accordance with GR914) before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation.

7. The right is reserved to alter or change the location of classes if time demands.

8. PRIZE MONEY will be applied to the exhibitor's outstanding account if any, or mailed to the exhibitor as listed on the entry blank within 30 days of the close of the show. Checks void after 60 days. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check. Prize Money will NOT be redistributed in any class for which there are fewer entries than places awarded. Awards over \$600 will not be issued without a Federal ID or Social Security Number. 1099 forms will be issued for all prize money over \$600.

9. REFUNDS: No refunds on stalls after the closing date. If a horse becomes injured or ill prior to being shown in any class, entry fees will be refunded upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. An office processing fee of \$60 per legitimately excused animal will be deducted from the refund. All certificates to be considered must be received by show management before the first day of the show or issued by Fairfield Equine Practice if the injury occurs while on the grounds.

10. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a MANDATORY LINE. The same will be indicated on course diagrams and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

11. STALLS: LIMITED STABLING AVAILABLE! All requests for stabling will be considered on a first come, first served basis. Temporary stabling of canvas construction with doors available at \$250 per stall. Stalls ordered after closing date are \$275. No initial bedding provided. No wiring of any kind allowed in the stabling area. Closing date to reserve stalls is July 29, 2020. Absolutely no refunds on stalls after closing date. Horses will be permitted to arrive on the grounds after 10:00 AM on Wednesday, August 12, 2020. \$20 Night watch will be automatically applied unless specified otherwise by exhibitors. Subletting stalls is not allowed. Any horses not paying a stall fee will be charged a \$50 ship-in/grounds fee. Stalls are approximately 10'x10', portable, under tents on dirt.

12. HAY & BEDDING orders may be placed with Agriventures Agway at (203)743-7500.

13. Riders to be properly attired for all classes. ASTM Approved protective headgear is required at all times when mounted. EQUUS Foundation arm bands have been approved as optional attire for all classes at Fairfield County Hunt Club horse shows.

14. Absolutely NO DOGS or other pets allowed on the grounds unless leashed and under control. \$150 fine for loose dogs.

15. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS for any and all classes, which require the same. If the horse show is fined for any incorrect membership, the exhibitor is responsible for the fine.

16. ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY July 29, 2020. All stall fees and deposits must be PRE-PAID by the closing date of entries. Signed open checks must accompany entries. Checks payable to "Fairfield County Hunt Club". Mail entries to Jessica Keil; 28 Maple Lane; Hudson, NY 12534 or complete online entries on [horseshowsonline.com](http://horseshowsonline.com).

17. The right is reserved to limit the number of entries accepted in any and all divisions. If entries must be limited, they will be selected on a first come first served basis, selected by postmark.

18. POST ENTRIES will be accepted at \$50 per horse, only if time permits. Entries will be accepted at a fee of \$75 per horse after the start of the show, if time permits.

19. Numbers will not be issued until a signed, open check is lodged with the horse show secretary and all USEF membership cards and measurement cards have been seen and verified.

20. ADDS & SCRATCHES: Entries must add and/or scratch classes prior to the beginning of the class with the show secretary. Horses shown in a class without being entered will pay a fee of \$30 in addition to the class entry fee. Horses that are not scratched prior to the start of the class will not have entry fees refunded.

21. OFFICE FEE of \$60 and AMBULANCE FEE of \$25 will be charged to each entry.

22. A fee of \$50 or 10% of check, whichever is greater will be charged to exhibitor's account for any returned check.

23. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

25. RING SIZES & FOOTING: Emerson Burr Ring 125X225, Sand; Jumper, Annex & Hunter Course, Grass.

25. CLASS SPECIFICATIONS and Rule Books are available at the secretary's desk for CHJA, NEHC, FW-PHA & Marshall & Sterling.

26. Every class offered herein which is recognized by the CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA Rules. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications and membership applications are available at the show secretary's office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net).

27. CAMPERS. Motor Homes or Trailers are not permitted.

28. MEASUREMENTS – By appointment with Fairfield Equine Associates.

29. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management, whose decision shall be final.

30. Prize Money for all Hunter Classes paid: 30%, 22%, 18%, 15%, 8%, 7%.

Prize Money for all Jumper Classes paid: 30%, 20%, 15%, 13%, 12%, 10%. Unless otherwise noted or required by USEF/USHJA RULES.

31. Jumper Nomination Fee \$165. Ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated.

32. At Federation licensed competitions horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinoepneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the  Released Parties  or  Event Organizers ), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ( Liability ) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

## 2021 Medal Finals and Hunter Classics

### 2020 Year End Awards

*To help our members and our affiliated horse shows recover from the effects the pandemic has had on the Connecticut horse community, the CHJA is happy to provide the following incentives for the 2020 CHJA Year End Awards and the 2021 CHJA Medal Finals and Hunter Classics.*

- ◆ All points currently earned towards the 2020 Medal Finals will count towards the 2021 Medal Finals!
- ◆ The qualifying period for the 2021 Medal Finals has been extended! It will run from August 1, 2019 until the last day of July in 2021!
- ◆ The number of points needed to qualify for the 2021 Medal Finals will remain at 10!
- ◆ The 2021 Master's Medal will be run at 3' 3".
- ◆ All points currently earned towards the 2020 Hunter Classics will count towards the 2021 Hunter Classics. Remember that the points belong to the horse that earned them and are not transferable.
- ◆ The qualifying period for the 2021 Hunter Classics has been extended! It will run from December 1, 2019 until the last day of July in 2021!
- ◆ To qualify for the 2021 Hunter Classics, you must qualify in either the Children's Hunter Horse, Children's Hunter Pony or the Adult Amateur Hunter Division (Over and Under 35 combined) by being in the top 30 (an increase over the current 25) of the division with a minimum of 50 points at the end of the qualifying period.
- ◆ The 2021 Hunter Classics will be run in the derby format.
- ◆ Starting in 2021, the Hunter Classics qualifying period will be the same as the Medal Finals qualifying period starting on August 1, 2021 and ending on July 31, 2022 for the 2022 Hunter Classics.
- ◆ Points earned towards 2020 CHJA Year End Awards will have point multipliers doubled until November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Basic points are increased by point multipliers which are determined by the number of entries that complete the class.

| Number of Entries | Current Multiplier | 2020 Multiplier |
|-------------------|--------------------|-----------------|
| 25 and Over       | 4                  | 8               |
| 17-24             | 3                  | 6               |
| 10-16             | 2                  | 4               |
| 3-9               | 1                  | 2               |

- ◆ Juniors in their last year in 2020 will have any points earned in the 2020 Junior Medal qualifying classes transferred to the Adult Medal for 2021. They also have the option of competing in the Master's Medal. Points earned in the 2020 Children's Medal qualifying classes will be transferred to the Modified Adult Medal for 2021. After December 1, 2020 they must compete in the Adult Medal qualifying classes or the Modified Adult Medal qualifying classes if they are not yet qualified.
- ◆ Juniors in their last year in 2020 points earned towards the 2020 Children's Hunter Horse Classic will be transferred to the Adult Hunter Classic for 2021. Hunter Classic points remain with the horse that earned them and are not transferable to another horse. After December 1, 2020 they must compete in the Amateur Adult Hunters Under 35 if they are not yet qualified.

*These changes were effective as of June 17, 2020 when the State of CT reopened for horse showing.*

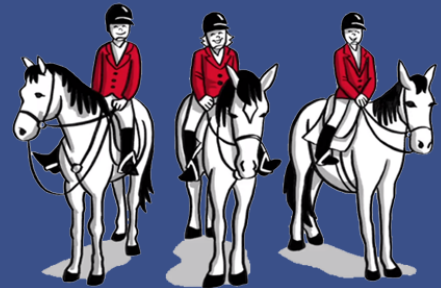
